

## **ISRAELI CHAMBER MUSIC COMPETITION**

Dear Students,

The School of Music is delighted to inaugurate a new competition — "The Competition for the Performance of Israeli Chamber Music".

The new contest is a result of the cooperation between the Buchmann-Mehta School of Music and the Israeli Music Information Center.

The contest is scheduled to take place in May 2015, close to the "Contemporary Music Competition".

Prizes to be awarded at the competition will be donated by the Israeli Music Information Center.

## **Regulations:**

- 1. The competition is open to all students of the Buchmann-Mehta School of Music.
- 2. Participating ensembles may consist of 3-6 members (without conductor).
- 3. Participants are required to choose a work from the catalogue of the Israeli Music Information Center (available at the school's library), or a work by an Israeli composer. Works by composition students will not be accepted. Works from the catalogue of the Israeli Music Information Center may be ordered by the library staff for examination. Ensembles may choose one or more movements from one work, or several short works. Duration of performance at the competition has to be 7-8 minutes at least, and must not exceed 15 minutes. Ensembles must receive consent from the head of the chamber music department on their choice of work.
- 4. Registration for the competition ends on March 20, 2015. Students planning to participate must inform the competition coordinator and the head of chamber music of their intent about two months before the competition itself, which is scheduled for May 26-27, 2015.
- 5. Ensembles are entitled to receive tuition once or twice only. Requests for tuition must be addressed to <a href="mailto:interprog@tauex.tau.ac.il">interprog@tauex.tau.ac.il</a>.
- 6. Issues regarding jury proceedings (jurors, system of evaluation) will be identical to those used in the Contemporary Music Competition.
- 7. Prizes will be awarded by the Israeli Music Information Center.
